

THE SILVER MEDALLIONS

As you know, we have issued 300 sterling silver medallions with the school emblem on one side and on the other written in Armenian "I too contributed a stone".

These medallions are bestowed on persons who donate \$1,000 or more to the school building fund. One medallion is bestowed per person per year. Usually they are given at the celebration of the school Feastday, the feastday of St. Gregory the Illuminator.

As they are limited number, they will soon become collectors' item.

This year, these Medallions will be bestowed by His Beatitude, Jean Pierre KASPARIAN our Patriarch on March 12, at the official blessing of the school.

THE GOLD MEDALLIONS

Gold Medallions, similar to the silver ones are bestowed on benefactors who donate \$100,000 or more to the school building fund. These Medallions are made of 18k solid gold.

Besides this medallion, such benefactor will have a classroom named by him/her.

To date, the Caloust GULBENKIAN FOUNDATION has donated \$US 75,000. Thus a classroom will be named "CALOUST GULBENKIAN".

Amongst our Benefactors, the most prominent name is that of our builder, Mr JOHN MERHI. As a token of appreciation for his work and help, the school will offer him a gold medallion, and a classroom will be named "JOHN MERHI".
